

Mini-Lesson: 5 Facts About Alice Paul

Grades: 2-6

Duration: approximately 20 minutes

OBJECTIVE:

Students will watch a short video about Alice Paul and answer 5 questions.

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Give students time to watch the video (on YouTube) entitled: **5 Facts on Alice Paul's Fight for Women's Equality**

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QUESTIONS:

1. How was Alice Paul inspired to fight for women's rights?
2. What was the official name of the first women's march in Washington, D.C.?
3. How many times was Alice Paul arrested in her fight for women's rights?
4. What did former President Woodrow Wilson say about "universal suffrage"?
5. What year was Alice Paul inducted into the National Women's Hall of Fame?
