Site History

Discover Paulsdale, a National Historic Landmark listed on the New Jersey and National Registers of Historic Places. This New Jersey treasure is the birthplace and family home of Alice Stokes Paul—a woman who courageously led the final campaign for women's right to vote and authored the Equal Rights Amendment. Paulsdale, now restored to appear as it did when Alice Paul lived here from 1885 to 1920, offers a variety of interior and exterior spaces suitable for meetings and special events.







MEETING COSTS

Our space is available for both half-day and full day increments for up to 40 guests. Rental times include both setup and breakdown periods for the event. Please note that renters will not have access to the venue before 8 AM or after 6 PM.

EVENT COSTS

FRIDAY	\$2,500.00
SATURDAY	\$3,500.00
SUNDAY	\$2,000.00

Each rental includes a 7-hour window from 4 PM to 11 PM, with the following schedule:

• 4–5 PM: Setup

 Access to the venue will begin at 4 PM; renters will not be permitted entry before this time.

• 5-10 PM: Event

 All events must conclude by 10 PM in accordance with the Township of Mount Laurel's noise ordinance.

• 10–11 PM: Breakdown

 Renters are responsible for removing all event items, except those belonging to a rental company, by 11 PM. All rental items must be picked up by the day after the event. Any items left behind will be discarded, and a cleanup fee will be deducted from the Damage Deposit.
